Class Sizes: School population shifts quite a bit, given the transient nature of the area.

- 1. State of VA Requirement: Membership Report is completed in October (school counts are taken)
- 2. Planning & Enrollment Projection: A 10 year projection is completed annually and generally falls within 1% of actual enrollment.
 - a. K-2: 22 Students
 - b. 3-5: 26 Student

Enrollment meetings are held as part of the budgeting process to ensure funds are distributed appropriately across the district.

Schools occasionally see a large influx of students, there are additional funds set aside in the budget to address this.

Teacher pipeline is low, which has made hiring teachers more difficult.

Redistricting: What is the anticipated impact on JH?

Boundary Analysis was completed across Alexandria Elementary Schools.

In SY22-23 JH enrollment was 393 (K-5) with 362 of these students living in the district. Capacity at JH is 407.

Tutoring will occur Monday-Thursday, Reading and Math will each take place 2x/week

Intervention and enrichment times have been built into the Master Schedule.
